## The Whole Bible for the Whole Church: Part One: Introduction to the Old Testament

In this course, we will consider in a survey fashion both the Old and New Testaments. Usually in the church context, we are exposed to selected passages used for preaching and teaching purposes, and we do not often explore the entire Bible in a systematic way and in all its context. This course will provide such an opportunity.

In the Fall, we will consider the Old Testament book by book, highlighting certain themes that are emphasized by the authors. We will examine such questions as the authorship, historical context, the literary style and the unique contribution of each author to the salvation history leading to Christ. We will also consider the nature of revelation and inspiration.

In the Winter Quarter course offering, we will study again the Whole Bible for the Whole Church focusing on the New Testament. The focus will be the historical background of the New Testament, the nature of the Gospels, and the contribution of each book to our Biblical and Theological understanding of the faith which we proclaim and practice as the church today, the Body of Christ.
